Liskeard Sector Update

We have seen some positive performance indicators over the past 6 months. We have improved our investigation supervision which together with the hard work of our investigators means we are now investigating 180 less crimes than we were in June 2024. We have increased our arrest rates for Domestic Abuse offences 20%. Our immediate response times have also improved from 38% to 55%.

Key highlights

- Liskeard Station front office making good progress and due to open in January 2025
- Torpoint - PC Gething has been recognised as the best problem solver in force.
- TSSO Megan Buckley from Torpoint was first on scene at the Looe land train incident and performed exceptionally well.
- Saltash PCSO Starts in Feb / March
- Hate Crime awareness week – focused on business and retail crime with positive feedback from diversity business owners and workers.
- Summer ASB Patrols in Looe, Saltash and Torpoint were well received by local residents and Cllr's.
- Warrant focus week – seen a reduction in those wanted on warrant reduce from 12 – 5.
- Knife Arche event Liskeard ENTE – Great success with positive engagement from the ENTE community in Liskeard.
- December plans for Drink drive Op Limits events in every area.
- 2025 will see 14 new officers arriving into sector.
