Application for tree works within a TPO Area: T1 - Oak - Re pollard one oak by approximately 2.5 meters back to previous cut points as indicated in the photos whilst being mindful to maintain shape and form keeping the maximum cut diameter under 50mm. T2 - Crimson Maple - Reduce one crimson maple by 1.5 meters over the property to prevent the canopy projecting further. T3 - Oak - Reduce one over extended oak limb over the property by 2.5 meters taking it back to the average crown line

All three volunteer Wardens reviewed these applications, in each case from the roadside.

Application for tree works within a TPO Area:

- T1 Oak Re pollard one oak by approximately 2.5 meters back to previous cut points as indicated in the photos whilst being mindful to maintain shape and form keeping the maximum cut diameter under 50mm.
- T2 Crimson Maple Reduce one crimson maple by 1.5 meters over the property to prevent the canopy projecting further.
- T3 Oak Reduce one over extended oak limb over the property by 2.5 meters taking it back to the average crown line

COMMENT: These are sensible and realistic options for the long-term preservation of these three fine street-side trees. We note that there is no intention to remove the ivy on T1, and we approve of that as ivy provides excellent wildlife habitat.
