Comparison of Fees & Charges for Plymouth City Council and Cornwall Council

A comparative analysis of burial service fees charged by Saltash Town Council against those of neighbouring authorities—Plymouth City Council (**Appendix A**) and Cornwall Council (**Appendix B**) was undertaken. The aim is to assess the competitiveness and sustainability of Saltash's current fee structure.

Saltash Town Council's fees are notably lower across most service categories. This is largely due to Saltash not being subject to the higher overhead costs faced by the adjoining councils. Among the three, Plymouth charges the highest fees, while Cornwall's rates fall between Plymouth and Saltash.

One key difference lies in the duration of Exclusive Rights of Burial (ERB): Plymouth and Cornwall offer terms ranging from 25 to 50 years, whereas Saltash provides a 10-year term. Although shorter, this approach promotes ongoing engagement with residents and ensures continued value and flexibility recommended by the Institute of Cemetery and Crematorium Management (ICCM).
