Hi Dawn

There is no formal statement of compliance other than the Accessibility statement on the website. This means no errors show up on the scans run all pages on Axe and Wave tools, and manual checks have also not revealed any errors. PDFs are OK although there may be errors, primarily in document headers – authorship, title, etc., and there may be formatting errors, but these are inconsequential for most documents, including Minutes, Agendas, Policies, etc.

The main PDF failure are (ironically) the Annul Governance Statements, which are scans, and which cannot be read by text to voice software, but there is currently no alternative available.

Provided care is taken updating the website, e.g. not adding images with text without alternative text, not copying and pasting from Word, etc., the site should continue to be compliant indefinitely, or until the next update to WCAG.
