Stockton Roundabout.

This is still on track for completion during the Autumn, one thing we are seeing is the amount of drivers turning right.

With this in mind Montel will now be putting enforcement camera's in. This could result in points and a fine being given to Drivers who are caught.

Moditonham Estate, Botus Fleming.

There has been a concern raised by residents living in the Moditonham estate, ref the Fire action Plan.

They were concerned that in an event of a fire in the estate, the response time would be hampered by 2 posts that are 2.5 metres apart in getting the trucks through. I contacted the Saltash Fire Station and raised this with them.

On a training night they took the Engine down and it was a tight squeeze to get through and then further down the lane near the quay they struggled some more.

Discussions were held and it was decided that Saltash would respond but also Callington, Callington have a smaller response vehicle. With that in mind a new Fire Action Plan was set up.

Anti-Social Behaviour.

We are now seeing a rise in ASB from Motorbike and E-bike riders, we are seeing Motorbikes in and around Saltash, with some bikes higher than 500cc pulling wheelies down New Road.

Motorbikes above 50cc riding on pathways with no consideration for pedestrians old or young. This is an accident waiting to happen.

A couple of weeks ago we had an accident on St Stephens Rd, is this the start of more accident waiting to happen. I am facilitating a meeting between Police and residents.
