VOLUNTARY TREE WARDENS REPORT

PA22/11178 Ash trees behind Lewis Mews , New Road

Our chief concern in this group of trees (and not subject to this application) is the preservation of the magnificent and ancient horse chestnut at the east end of the group virtually adjacent to the main road. This tree is substantially healthy except for various common leaf diseases and mites which occasionally infect the leaves.

Again we are disappointed to find the application confusing in places and in particular in relation to previous applications.

We remain concerned about the actual application as on the 15th of September 2021, the agents recommended some pruning work only to these two trees ,T9 and T13. We recognise that these trees are a common species but they remain important in the overall environment. When we looked at them before we thought them to be infected but in a satisfactory condition.

Accordingly : RECOMMEND STC AGREE SUBJECT ONLY TO VIEWING AND AGREEMENT BY COUNTY TREE OFFICER.
