

Report to Services Committee 7 February 2023

TREE SALTASH

Trees and hedgerows have been planted original sites (Library Hub, Brooking Way, Buller Park, Carew Gardens, Oaklands Green, Porter Way, Warraton Road and Yellowtor Road). They were all intact when recently inspected.

Trees and accessories are in store for further planting in Frobisher Drive and Prowse Rise which will be completed by the end of March 2023.

The Tree Wardens and volunteers have also helped in planting the British Legion oak on Jubilee Green, and trees/hedges (on private land) at Our Lady of the Angels Catholic Church.

A private donor has offered to pay for a standard tree for Broad Walk open space; the current plan is to provide additional protection for the tree in this vulnerable position by surrounding it with fencing and hawthorn hedge. We have been offered chestnut fencing from Tincombe which will suit the purpose, but will need stakes and hawthorn saplings (bare-rooted) to complete the project. A local resident's charity has provided funds which can be used to purchase the hawthorn. We would like to apply to Services Committee to fund stakes and bark from the environmental budget.
