
To receive a report on Pentreath mental health charity QR plaques for public places and consider and actions and associated expenditure.

Pentreath is a Cornwall based mental health charity who work directly with the NHS to support residents who are experiencing mental health difficulties. They aim to promote good mental health through personal development with the longer term goal of accessing further training and employment.

Pentreath have designed plaques to go on public places such as benches, noticeboards and fencing. The plaque is fitted either with screws or adhesive and is designed to be long lasting and weather proof. Plaques would be required to be fitted by the Service Delivery Department. The plaques are free of charge and take around 4 weeks from point of ordering.
