To receive a report from Saltash Environmental Action and consider any actions and associated expenditure.

The Council may be pleased to note that two quite fine-looking (unusual though not very rare) flowers are out at Pillmere Meadow today (5th June). The sainfoin, and the bee orchid. This year, two bee orchids out at the same time, about 10 meters apart. As I understand it, last year's bee orchid on this site was registered with the Botanical Society of Britain and Ireland, and will eventually appear in their atlas.
