Overview:

No further information has been provided from the Plymouth City Council events team after several requests.

Recently the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Town Clerk met with Plymouth City Councillors Sue Haydon, Pat Patel and John Dingle who all represent St Budeaux Ward.

During the meeting commemorating D-Day 80 in unison with Plymouth was discussed, this included the lighting of a beacon at 9:15pm on 6th June 2024 and the possibility of a Ribbon of Poppies across the Tamar Bridge. A further meeting was proposed to be held in early 2024 to further progress the event, working in partnership.

The Town Clerk has recently communicated with Plymouth City Council members to arrange a follow up meeting and is currently awaiting a response.
